Call for applications	All the required documents should be sent to

	separately). Once accepted as an Erasmus+
	participant, you will receive an official
	acceptance letter and information materials.

Selection criteria/Score system	A person who can apply for the Erasmus+
	Program must:
	1. be a full-time or part-time student of a
	university;
	2. know foreign language at the level specified
	in the IIA;
	3. have an average score in subjects at the
	level of at least 82 points;
	4. not be on academic leave at the time of
	departure.
Priority	1. quality of the application form;
	2. average score in subjects at the level of at
	least 82 points;
	3. knowledge of the relevant foreign language
	at the B1 level (or as determined at IIA);
	4. In the exact evaluation of candidates,
	preference will be given to students with
	disabilities, internally displaced students, or
	persons in difficult financial situations.
Selection Committee	The selection of candidates consists of three
	stages:

Stage 1: preliminary selection of candidates
based on submitted documents. Creating a
rating of candidates.
Stage 2: direct selection, which will be carried
out by the commission for the selection of
candidates for participation in the Erasmus+
program, with representatives of Lesya
Ukrainka Volyn National University
participating.
Stage 3: After the commission selects
candidates, the list of selected persons is sent
to the partner educational institution, where
the final selection decision is made.
All candidates will be individually informed
about the selection results. If the selected
candidate refuses to participate, a person
from the reserve list will be given the
opportunity to join the program in the next
sequence.

Selection criteria	A person who can apply for financing must:
	to be a scientific-pedagogical (scientific)
	employee of a university;

submit an application for a trip to a partner institution within the framework of the relevant field of study (where employed), with which there is a signed Erasmus+ agreement. In order to comply with the selection procedure and further complete the package of documents before the end of the selection period, the individual stay program for the purpose of preliminary approval at the partner institution must first be sent exclusively and directly to the contact person at the university 10 days before the end of the application deadline (at the address given below) without any previous contacts of the candidates with the partner institution. The agreed individual program will be sent to the candidate before the end of the selection period. Priority/Restrictions Evaluation of the individual stay program (only fully completed packages of documents, agreed, in the form of signatures, by the head of the relevant structural unit of the university and the head of the structural unit/contact person of the partner institution will be considered); also, preference will be given to scientific and pedagogical workers who took/participated in jointly organized events and/or projects with a partner university. During the candidate selection procedure, men and women, as well as persons with disabilities, will be given equal conditions and chances. **Application documents** Required documents: individual stay program, according to a sample with signatures of both parties (scan

or fax) (i.e. Staff Mobility for Teaching Mobility
Agreement);
certificate from the place of work;
a certificate/certificate of knowledge of a
foreign language at the B2 level, directly
certified by the head of the structural unit;
a copy of the first page of the foreign
passport.
Documents should be submitted no later
than the deadline for submitting applications

of Lesia Ukrainka University, Voli Ave., 13,

II. Recognition procedure

Recognition of student mobility	
Documents	The basis for recognizing study results is an
	academic certificate provided by the student,
	certified by the established procedure, a student's
	study plan (record book) or an appendix to a diploma
	of previous education, and a graduate student's
	individual plan of educational and scientific work.
Procedure	Learning results from educational components are
	re-enrolled based on a comparison of the study plans
	of the relevant speciality (educational-professional,
	educational-scientific program) and the Academic
	certificate, individual study plan or scorebook, or
	individual plan of educational-scientific work
	provided by the Participant. At the same time, during
	the recognition of the forms of the final control from
	the educational components, the exam can be
	counted as a credit with a corresponding grade on
	the ECTS scale.
	The Subject Committee (from now on referred to as
	the Committee), established by the dean (director)

order, makes decisions regarding the recognition of study periods and credits received in formal education. The Committee can recommend full recognition, limited recognition, and non-recognition. In the Erasmus + program, full automatic recognition of all credits is ensured (based on the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System—ECTS), as agreed in the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education (ECHE).
