

Insurance Declaration for Erasmus+ Traineeships

Participation in the Erasmus+ programme does **not include** any kind of insurance coverage.

Each participant shall have adequate insurance coverage for their internship abroad. The following insurances are mandatory and have to be verified on request:

- Health insurance valid in the country of destination
Check with your health insurance in Germany whether it is valid in the destination country!
In addition to the German health insurance (e.g. European Health Insurance Card), we recommend that you also have international health insurance.
- Private accident insurance
- Private liability insurance

Medical students may require separate professional liability insurance. Please inform yourself about this before starting the internship and make sure you have the appropriate insurance cover.

You are free to choose the insurance company.

All Erasmus+ participants (including recent graduates) have the option to take part in the group insurance offered by the DAAD (Tarif 720). Health, accident and liability insurance are included.
