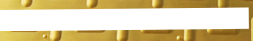

Well-known in France for the friendliness of the local people and the warmth of its welcome, Saint-Etienne's population numbers over 170,000. Saint-Étienne has the honor of being the only French city designated Creative City of Design by the UNESCO.

How to get to Saint-Étienne from Paris

You can arrive from two international airports in Paris

- Paris Charles de Gaulle Airport
- Orly Airport

After arriving in Paris, go to Gare de Lyon, whether by bus or taxi, to take a direct TGV linking Paris to Saint-Étienne in just 2 hours and 45 minutes.

4 trains commute each day between the capital city and our city. <https://www.sncf-connect.com/>

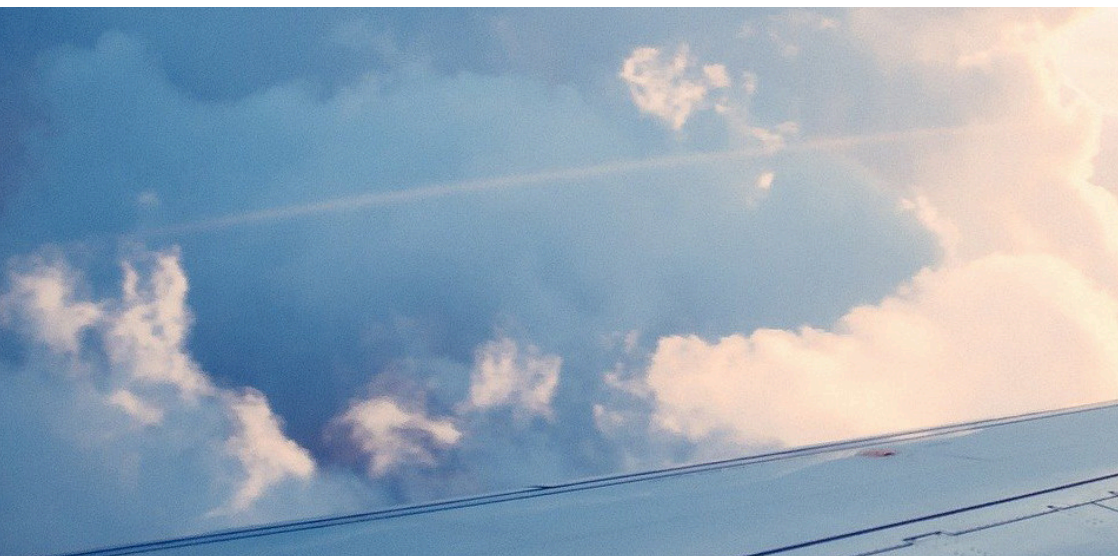
There is also an over, non-direct, way for coming to Saint-Étienne passing through Lyon-Part-Dieu train station.

In both cases, the arrival station is Saint-Étienne Châteaureux, the main station of the city.

How to get to Saint-Étienne from Lyon

1. From Lyon-Saint-Exupéry International Airport

Follow the direction in the airport to take the shuttle Rhônexpress to Lyon-Part-Dieu train station, leaving every 20 min from 5am to midnight.

Ticket one way : 16€70

2. From Lyon-Part-Dieu train station

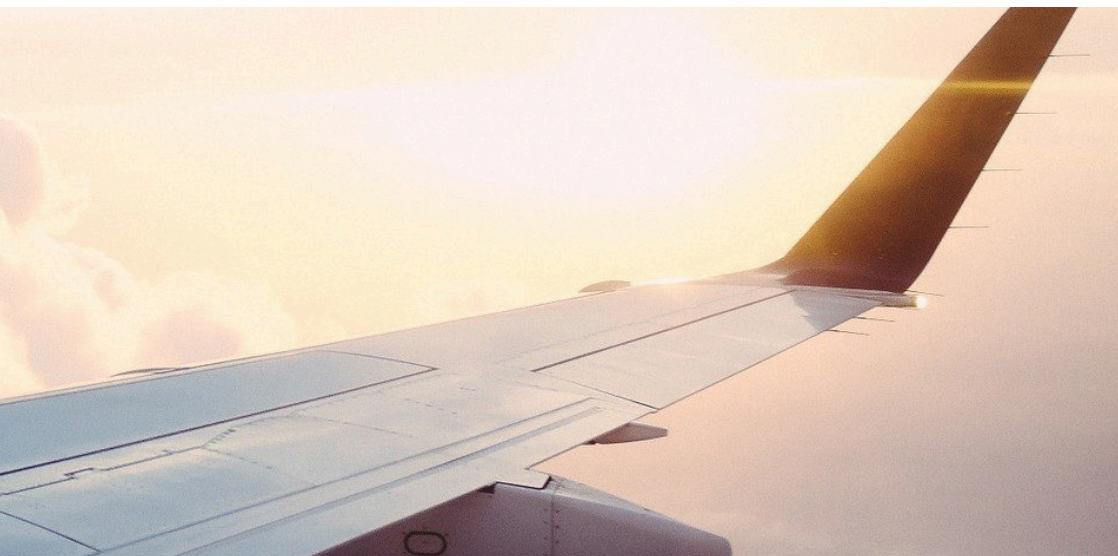
From Lyon to Saint-Étienne, trains take about 45 min. Get off at Saint-Étienne Châteaureux train station.

Check the display boards for the platform that matches the train to hop on.

Buy a ticket from a self-service machine or from a ticket counter, costing about 14 €

Remember to date-stamp the ticket before getting on the train. Use yellow machines which can be found at every corner of the train station to do so.

Trefilerie Campus / Saint-Étienne

Located in city center, Trefilerie Campus covers a large number of disciplines with Departments of Law, Art- Literature-Languages, Humanities and Social Sciences, the Institute of Business Administration, the Saint-Etienne School of Economics, the Department of Political and Territorial Studies as well as numerous research laboratories. In addition, the campus houses the headquarters of the university with general departments, services and the student life.



Health Innovations Campus / Saint-Étienne

This campus hosts the Faculty of Medicine, next to the University Hospital. It unites two regional platforms : the Regional Institute of Medicine and Engineering of Sport (IRMIS) and the Hyg e center dedicated to health prevention.



Manufacture Campus / Saint-Étienne

The campus is emblematic of an ecosystem combining the academic university and economic world. It hosts the Hubert Curien Laboratory, the Faculty of Science and Technology, the Engineering School T el ecom Saint-Etienne, the incubator Us'In, the private company HEF, the Knowledge Centre for Innovation and the Fabrique de l'Innovation through the D-Factory.



Metare Campus / Saint- tienne

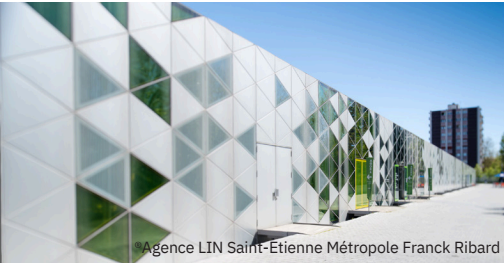
This campus houses the Faculty of Science and Technology including its seven departments (biology-biochemistry, chemistry, computer science, sports education, mathematics, physics, and geology) on which several research laboratories rely and the University Institute of Technology of Saint- tienne.



Campus of Roanne / Roanne

Division of the University, this campus offers undergraduate and master courses. The University Institute of Technology of Roanne is also located there, with some specificities. Research activities are carried out in the Laboratory for Analysis of Signals and Industrial Processes (LASPI).

City of Design

In the heart of the creative district, the City of Design raises awareness of challenges and uses of design to the public.



Mine Museum

Right in the middle of a mining site labelled as a historic monument, this museum is an exceptional heritage site enlightening about the coal world and its miners.



Museum of Art & Industry

It has three technical collections of national and international scope: weapons, cycles and ribbons. These collections are the link between the past, present and future of Saint- Etienne.



Museum of Modern & Contemporary Art

Its art collection is the most important in France. It includes a majority of works from the 20th century as well as collections of design, ancient art and photographs.
