Information on Qualis


- Qualis is an internal university evaluation program within the framework of the Quality

- Courses offered by all faculties and courses offered by study-related institutions are evaluated.


Details on the Qualis survey

- The basic form consists of 28 items, one free-response item as well as basic demographic variables.
- For purposes of analysis, individual items of the basic form are aggregated into five scales (Lecturer, Structure, Topic, Requirements, Overall Assessment) and reported in terms of these scales.
- The basic form is amended by additional scale items (e.g. presentations, work assignments, digital teaching) based on each course's specific assessments.

The learning objectives for the course were clear to me.






The flexibility associated with the online format (location, time, learning pace) allowed me to engage more intensively with the lecture content than in a traditional face-to-face course.

The course was too difficult for me.














The scope of the capstone project overwhelmed me.

Further remarks: Suggestions for improvements

"The time limits of presentation are a bit short, especially if you design a bigger prototype"

"maybe some multidisciplinary studies/projects with other program students, e.g. industrial design students etc cuz it would make the information swapping/exchanging more concrete"

"More creditpoints. 9CP for example"

"The class is very well-organized and one of the best developed in my time at Saarland University. Unfortunately, Morana lacks 'rizz' as the young people would say. I did not feel very comfortable attending the in-person sessions after the 5th or so lecture because I felt like I was in a place where I could safely express my ideas in learning. I think Morana could work on communicating in a way that doesn't come off as snarky so that shy and introverted students like me feel comfortable attending."

"I liked that the Capstone Project was quite openly designed. But I found it difficult to start and end the project. Therefore a small demonstration of 3-4 past Projects, from start to finish would be helpful."

"A more clear communication of the goal of the Capstone Project at the beginning of the course. Because the first weeks it was very unclear for us what we really have to do."

Further remarks: Suggestions for improvements

"more engagement of enbw in terms of being well prepared. Sometimes they did not watch the video beforehand."

"I think this course is too much effort for 6 ECTS points. Also I think you should either drop the capstone report or one of the exams. I also feel that since the final exam is only 1 hour, it feels a bit overwhelming to lean all of the chapters starting from chapter 5 for it als you can either not go into detail with the question which is a bit sad if you study everything in detail or you can't ask about everything which then also sucks if we have to learn everything. Maybe rethink either the compensation for the course or change the exam format/ report."

"Choose one: either a lecture with midterm and exam or a complete course for project work. To split it like this is way to complex with a the channels (lecture, exercises, video, presentation, report...)"

Further remarks regarding the course (praise/criticism)

"It appears quite fair"

"Finish Capstone a little earlier in the Semester"

"Wonderful teachers. They were really engaged and active. I only would've liked it more if Prof. Dr. Morana would've participated in the Thursday meetings"

"A really interesting and well structured course with 2 motivated dozents. But it was really much workload with 6CP with Report etc."

"lecture was well done structured. Awesome and fresh approach."

"Both the professor and teaching assistant were very engaged and I highly appreciated their course. I had fun in the class which facilitates studying for me personally. Even though I made some criticism before I recommend this course."

"Workload is too much."

"Stefan and Christian are very engaged. lecture takes way to much time in comparison with other courses and cou can't focus on one thing (either Lecture or project). The project should be way closer supervised. The Schnellbächer chair focuses on project work [...]

Further remarks regarding the course (praise/criticism)

[...] that you actually get frequent feedback and learn how to work in groups. That would make much more sense to learn how to apply the HCD with the help of the supervisors (not only the feedback opportunity with EnBw, those guys were really not helpful at all)"

"The work load was too much for 6 CP. Especially the Capstone project. At least the report could be removed from the project. I like that the typical lecture were online as videos and I could watch them whenever I like to"
