How to come to the university of Saarbrücken

From Frankfurt airport to Saarbruecken central station

If you arrive at Frankfurt airport, there are two different railway stations at the airport. You can either take a long-distance train (short: ICE or IC) from Frankfurt to Saarbruecken, departing from Fernbahnhof (short: Fernbf), or you take a regional train (short: RE) from Regionalbahnhof (short: Regionalbf). Regional trains are recommended since there are non-stop connections available, but you can take both kinds of trains. Tickets are available from the machines on the platforms or near the stations.

From the central station to the university

If you want to go from the central station directly to the university, you have several opportunities. The busses 102, 112 and 124 connect the central station with the university without having to change. Another opportunity is to take the tram S1 (direction Brebach or Kleinblittersdorf) to the stop "Johanniskirche", there please change to the bus stop "Rathaus". From here the busses 102 and 111 (direction Dudweiler) go directly to the university.

From the central station to your hotel and to the university

Usually our visitors stay in hotels which are situated in or near the city center of Saarbruecken. All hotels are reachable within a walking distance from the central station (about 1 km) or with the tram S1 to the stops "Johanniskirche" or "Landwehrplatz".

The busses to the university start at the bus stop "Rathaus" (next to the city hall). The busses 102 and 111 (direction Dudweiler) go directly to the university.

Hotels around the stops "Johanniskirche" and "Rathaus" are Hotel Hamburg, Hotel Leidinger, Hotel Madeleine and Motel One. To make orientation easier, we have included a map of the city and the campus.

On the Campus

The bus stops three times on the campus. Once right before the main gate, then again on the main square of the university and the third time at the bus stop Mensa (see "H" on the attached campus map). This is where you should get off the bus. Continue in the direction the bus goes and turn to the right after about 50 m. On the right you will find the math building, number E2 4. Our offices are on the first floor, Roland Speicher's office is 2.01.
